Print Drug <P>DE Number or <C>oncession No or <N>ursing Home code or lank after the Patient Name on the Label (H for Hospital & Ward)

** IMPORTANT TO NOTE this setting is overridden by Print Quantity after Drug **

P= Drug PDE will print after the patient name - in the example below it appears as (536 970)



C = Concession Number will print after the patient's name in the example below it appears as (5034106928)





N = Nursing Home, will print after the patient name. In the example below the Nursing Home is "WEB", the Room is "ROOM" followed by the bed "BED" this prints as (WEB-ROOM/BE)



W=Ward, the ward will print out after that patients Name in the example below it appears as (WARD)





B= Blank, nothing will print after the patient name



H=Hospital, the nursing home\hospital and ward will print after the patient name, in the example below the the Hospital is "WEB" and the Ward id "WARD" so it prints as "WEB-WARD" **please not this setting is only for pharmacies that have Fred Hospital
